2017 General Rules & Information

General Rules:

1. The Finney County Spring Show is open to **youth only**. Out of state exhibitors welcome.
2. All exhibitors must be members of 4-H or FFA.
3. Exhibitors must own and exhibit their own animals including showmanship. (Exception: If exhibitor has 2 or more animals in same class.) Only animals entered in show are eligible for showmanship classes.
4. Pre-entries are recommended but not required. Entries will be accepted the day of the show, but will incur higher entry fees.
5. Fairgrounds will be open to receive entries on Friday, May 19, at 11AM
6. All exhibitors are expected to keep their areas clean at all times.
7. Finney County will not be held responsible for any damages to, or losses of, property for the duration of the show.
8. The show management reserves the right to alter and/or combine classes as seen fit. Three entries are required to constitute a breed class in all Swine, Sheep and Beef. If three entries representing one breed are not received entries will be shown as AOB.
9. No intact male animals may be shown.
10. Livestock that is shown in breeding classes CANNOT be shown in market classes too.
11. Lambs will show slick shorn & free of active club lamb fungus lesions.
12. Weathers and does may be shown in the Prospect Meat Goat Show and will be shown clipped to 3/8" or less. Breeding does are not required to be clipped.
13. All goats and sheep must have an official USDA Premise Tag to be eligible for the show.
14. All classes will be split by weight. 200 pound weight limit on prospect market hogs. The show management reserves the right for weigh back. 10 pound weigh back on hogs. 5 pounds on sheep and goats. 10% on beef.
15. All cattle will be show "Blow & Go." The use of paint, glue/adhesives and boning soaps will NOT be allowed. No hair coloring will be allowed in grooming of any beef exhibit. Attempts to alter animal color of breed character including the addition of hair or other added material, natural or manmade is prohibited. All beef exhibits will be subject to inspection and handling by the Cattle Superintendents and/or their agents at any time.
16. Registration papers are not required for breeding animals. All breeding stock will show by breed or age.
17. Due to limited space, exhibitors are encouraged to show out of their trailers. Generators are welcome. Parking is only allowed in designated areas of the Fairgrounds.
