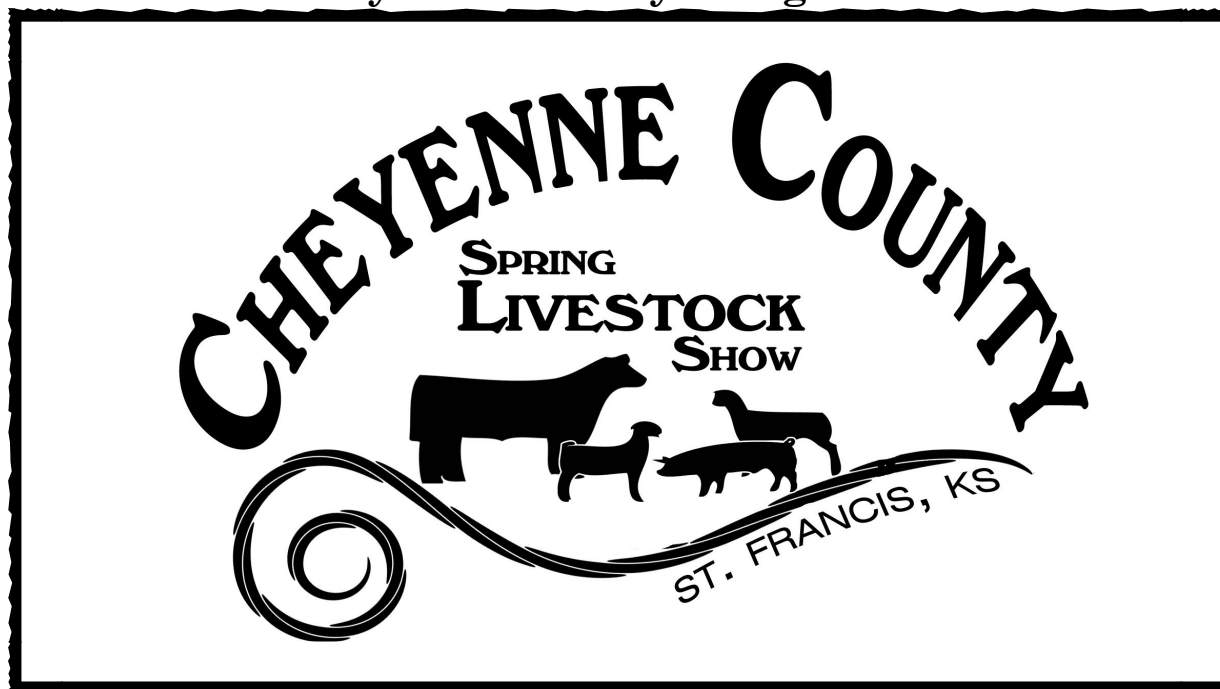

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## General Rules

1. The show is open to any bona fide 4-H or FFA Member. Ages 7-18 years old as of Jan. 1 of current year, 4-H rules.
2. All animals must have a 4-H ear tag in place or a permanent I.D. such as a tattoo.
3. **This is a Blow & Show Spring Show. No paint, adhesive, oil or powder will be allowed.**
4. **Entry fees:** pre-registered and pay day of the show are \$20.00/ beef animal, \$15.00/ sheep, goats and swine. Day of the show entry fees: \$25.00/ beef animal, \$20.00/ sheep, goats and swine. \$10.00/ showmanship entry with prizes to the top two places.

5. Pre-registration can be done on-line at [www.sunflower.ksu.edu](http://www.sunflower.ksu.edu) by **June 1<sup>st</sup>**.
6. No limit on the number of entries. Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal in the class. If 2 or more animals are in one class, another 4-H or FFA member may assist. (Subject to show committee approval)
7. Breed classes must have 3 or more of one breed (or market heifers) to establish a class. Otherwise they will be in the AOB class.
8. Heifers, ewes and does are eligible to show as market and breeding; exhibitor must enter both divisions at registration and pay double entry fee.
9. All market beef, market lambs, market goats and market swine will be judged as show prospects broken into classes by weight, not evaluated as finished market animals.
10. The show committee, upon completion of the official weigh-in period will divide the classes by weight, breed & birthdate. The show committee reserves the right to combine or add classes as they see fit.
11. No entries will be accepted after completion of weigh in.
12. Only barrows and gilts will be allowed to show in the swine division.
13. Sheep must be slick shorn with-in 3 days of the show; includes above the knee, hock and belly.
14. Bracing goats and medium/3MM or smaller pinch collars are allowed and horns must be tipped.
15. All animals must be free of infectious diseases or they will be dismissed from the grounds. Lambs and goats will be inspected for club lamb fungus by D.V.M. and must have a scrapie tag.
16. The Show Committee and Extension Staff reserve the right to remove from the grounds any exhibitor, animal or person that may be deemed objectionable to them.
17. Barns will be open for any participants who wish to bring their animals the night before. Arrangements must be made with the Extension Office before June 3, (785) 332-3171.
18. All exhibitors are expected to keep their stalls clean during the show and clean up stalls and other tack areas at the close of the show. **No bedding is allowed.**
19. Due to limited space, come prepared to show sheep, goats and swine out of trailers.
20. The purpose of this show is to provide a positive educational experience for youth in the 4-H/FFA livestock programs.
