Meade County Extension will be hosting a Hunter Hack Clinic on June 3rd at the Meade County Fairgrounds. The clinic will start at 9:00 AM and go until shortly after lunch or longer if needed. Karrie Miller of Meade will instruct the clinic. Karrie comes from an extensive background of horses. She was a longtime 4-Her in Barton County and has also shown extensively in AQHA, as well as national championships in dressage. Karrie also placed 3rd in nation show jumping in her youth career. She was chosen as alternate for United States Pony Club team to compete in South Africa. Karrie still competes in her spare time and has taught riding lessons as a professional for 12 years. Please join us for a day of English Hunter Hack learning on June 3rd at the Meade County Fairgrounds.

Requirements for the Clinic:

- **English Tack and Attire preferred** but NOT required
- Youth under the age of 18 must wear an ASTM certified/SEI approved Helmet. Helmets must an ASTM/SEI sticker intact on the inside of the helmet and a date within the last five years. All riders are encouraged to wear a helmet.
- Riders should be comfortable riding at all gaits (walk, trot, canter, hand gallop) and come prepared to jump
- Good Attitude, Grit and Determination!

All levels of jumpers who are interested in jumping should attend.

If you have never jumped before by would like to try – this clinic is for you! We also encourage anyone wishing to polish their skills and learn more to attend. The clinic will be at 9:00 AM at the Meade County Fairgrounds (outdoor arena, weather permitting). Lunch will be provided to all clinic participants. We ask that parents or anyone auditing the clinic pay \$5 to cover lunch.
