## What you need to know about the 2025 NWKS District Free Fair.

- All 4-H Project entries are due by 5:00 PM MT on July 16, 2025.
- If you are enrolled in a 4-H Project, you may not enter exhibits related to that project in open class.
- Any projects added after the May 1st deadline may not be exhibited in the 4-H Division; they can exhibit in open class.

- If you are showing livestock, you will see your animals pre-registered, but you need to add them as a project entry.
- The reason you see them is that we have to input weights & tag numbers before FairEntry opens for registration.
- If you need help with your entries, please call the Extension Office at **785-890-4880** between the hours of **8:00 to noon & 1:00 5:00 PM MT**.
- Need a computer? We have one at the Extension Office.
- Once all entries are registered into FairEntry, reports will be generated. We will contact each family to stop by the Extension Office to pick up their fair packet (*packets will not be mailed*).
- Fair packets will have all individual fair schedules, livestock information, and entry cards.

- Entries are due on July 16, 2025, no later than 5 PM MT. Late entries are not accepted.

#### **Foods & Nutrition:**

 For food safety purposes, any food with custard and cream cheese type fillings and frostings, glazes, flavored oils, "canned" bread or cakes in a jar, or food requiring refrigeration will not be accepted.

#### Livestock:

• Page 61; Rule E - The livestock shows will be a no-fit show, "blow and show". No fit, at the Northwest Kansas District Free Fair, is defined as using no adhesive, glue, paint, creams, or powder products. Anything used to alter or enhance an animal's performance or look is illegal. Animals using show products will not be allowed to enter the show ring.

- The Style Revue Scripts are due July 16, 2025. Please email your typed script to ekalfaro@ksu.edu
- Continued for this year:
  - ✓ You're cost per wear script will be the participant's responsibility to bring to give to the judge.
  - ✓ Entry tags must be attached to the cost-per-wear form.
  - ✓ A picture of your outfit must be provided on the form.
  - ✓ A completed cost per wear form will be part of your judging score.
- The **Style Revue Judging** and the **Public Style Revue** will be at the First Baptist Church on Main St at 8:30 AM MT on Tuesday, July 29, 2025.
- The Style Revue is for buymanship, constructed, & recycled clothing projects. You may model two outfits per project.
- Public Style Revue Practice will follow the judging.
- It is required to model at the Public Style Revue at 6:00 PM MT to receive your premium.

1. To qualify to show at the Kansas State Fair Dog Show, the 4-H'er must have been awarded a blue or purple ribbon at a county or invitational 4-H show.

#### **Showmanship Beef**

- 1. Showmanship for livestock will be judged during their respective shows.
- 2. The livestock must be owned by the showman.
- 3. All beef exhibits must be shown haltered.

#### **Showmanship Goat**

- 1. Showmanship for livestock will be judged during their respective shows.
- 2. The livestock must be owned by the showman.
- 3. Goats must be shown with all four feet on the ground. Exhibitors may use a collar, a collar with a short lead, or a halter when showing. A medium (3mm or smaller) pinch collar will be allowed.
