Returning Sunflower District 4-H Members

 (4-H Council will pay Cheyenne & Wallace Counties' fee for members enrolling by December 1; select the "check" option.)
- Update your contact e-mail/phone/address information!
- Drop/add project deadline is May 1 unless a project requires earlier enrollment. (e.g., enroll in livestock projects prior to the spring weigh-in).

New Sunflower District 4-H Members

- Enroll in 4-H Online 2.0
- Choose projects
- Members may enroll at any time during the year, but must enroll and pay the enrollment fee by May 1 to participate in your county fair 4-H Division. (4-H Council will pay Cheyenne & Wallace Counties' fee for members enrolling by December 1, select the "check" option.)
- Identify all projects prior to participation in meetings or activities on 4-H Online 2.0!
- Drop/add project deadline is May 1 unless a project requires earlier enrollment. (e.g., enroll in livestock projects prior to the spring weigh-in).

As of December 1, the Extension Office reminders will only be sent to currently enrolled families.
